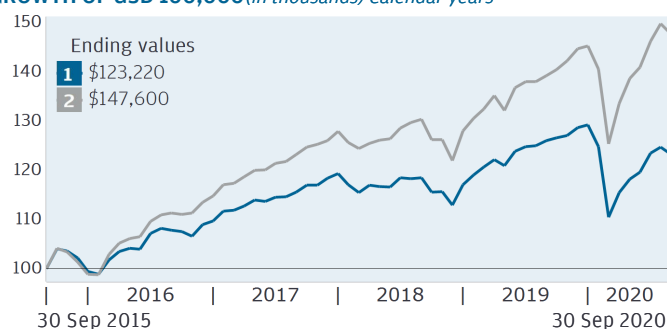

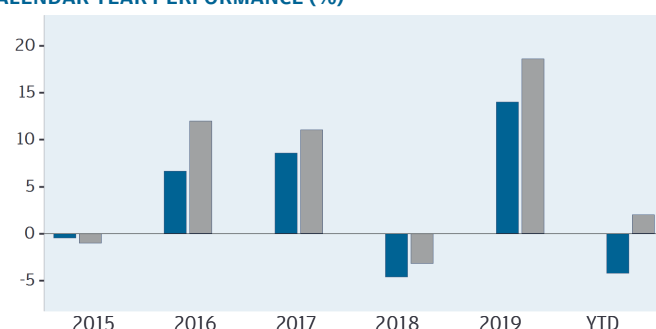

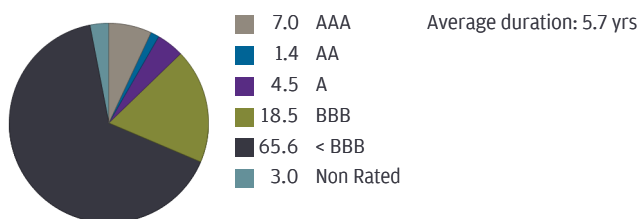

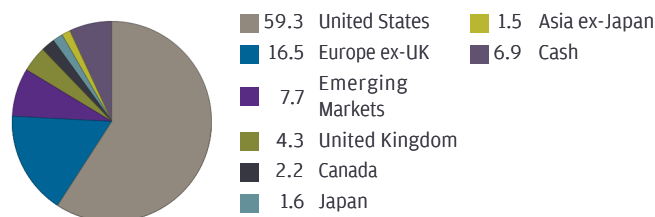

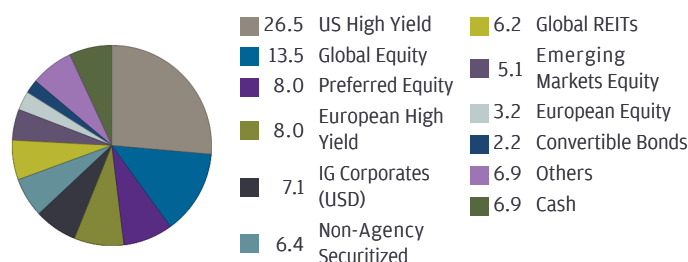

On 01/04/10 part of the element of the composite benchmark for the Fund changed from 10% Global Property Research 250 (Total Return Net) hedged into EUR to 10% FTSE EPRA/NAREIT Developed Index (Total Return Net) hedged into EUR.

#### DEFINITIONS

**Beta** a measure of a fund's sensitivity to market movements (as represented by the fund's benchmark). A beta of 1.10 suggests the fund could perform 10% better than the benchmark in up markets and 10% worse in down markets, assuming all other factors remain constant.

**Annualised volatility (%)** an absolute measure of volatility and measures the extent to which returns vary up and down over a given period. High volatility means that the returns have been more variable over time. The measure is expressed as an annualised value.

**Sharpe ratio** measures the performance of an investment adjusting for the amount of risk taken (compared a risk-free investment). The higher the Sharpe ratio the better the returns compared to the risk taken.
