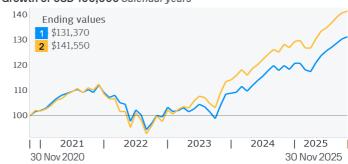

Definitions

NAV Net Asset Value of a fund's assets less its liabilities per Share. Overall Morningstar Rating™ assessment of a fund's past performance, based on both return and risk and shows how similar investments compare with their competitors. Beta measures a fund's sensitivity to market movements (as represented by the fund's benchmark). A beta of 1.10 suggests the fund could perform 10% better than the benchmark in up markets

and 10% worse in down markets, assuming all other factors remain constant. Usually the higher betas represent riskier investments. **Annualised volatility** (%) measures the extent to which returns vary up and down over a given period.

Sharpe ratio performance of an investment adjusting for the amount of risk taken (compared a risk-free investment). The higher the Sharpe ratio the better the returns compared to the risk taken.
